BOLON CARE+ GUIDELINES

Maintenance

Bolon is an advanced product. However, taking care of it is a surprisingly simple process.

Bolon can be cared for with eco-friendly cleaning products.

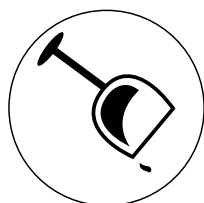


Regular Cleaning

- Start by vacuum cleaning.
- For spot cleaning, use a scrub brush, warm water and all-purpose cleaner with a pH of 7-8.5.
- Suck up the water with a wet vacuum cleaner or dry with soft cloth/micro-fiber cloth.

To Zero

- Start by vacuum cleaning.
- Remove any difficult stains (see Stain Removal).
- Use a scrub brush, warm water and alkaline all-purpose cleaner with a pH of 9-11.
- Scrub the floor and leave to work for 5-10 minutes.
- Scrub the floor again and rinse with clean water.
- Suck up the water with a wet vacuum cleaner or dry with soft cloth/micro-fiber cloth.



Stain Removal

- It is best if the stain is treated immediately.
- Check that the stain remover can be used on vinyl flooring.
- Use a scrub brush and rinse with water.

Stain	Clean With
Chocolate, juice, cream, coffee, beer, wine	Hot water with strong cleaner
Asphalt, oil, shoe cream, chalk, ink	Chemically pure petrol
Blood	Cold water - ammonia if needed
Rust	Light acidic (pH 3-4) cleaner
Water-based glue	Hot water
Solvent-based glue	Chemically pure petrol
Marks from shoes	Rub with dry cloth
Chewing gum	Hot steam or freeze spray
